















Helpful Tips: G Read&Write

Problem	Helpful tips/ ideas
Sign-in  problems	Make sure that you link data for your @sd28.org account 
 icon not present in extension toolbar	Click  top right corner and re-enable Read & Write 
Toolbar doesn't show up	 Click on rw purple puzzle piece to reload toolbar.
Toolbar not responding properly	 Refresh page (or Ctrl-r) reloads the webpage. Then click on  to get R&W toolbar.
Read&Write  doesn't show up in extension menu	 <p>Go to Settings & Extensions and toggle on Read&Write</p> 
Talk & Type  doesn't work	USB headsets work the best. Make sure to "Allow" use of microphone...Click  in URL bar ...Refresh page  and try again.

Troubleshooting Tips

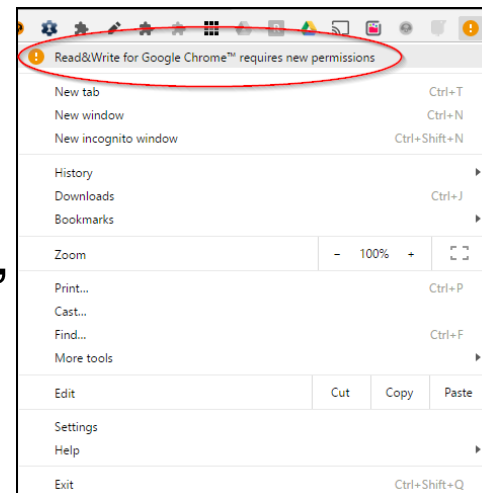
Tip#1: Use the refresh icon to reload page 

* sometimes the browser works better after doing this!


Tip#2: Read&Write icon isn't working?

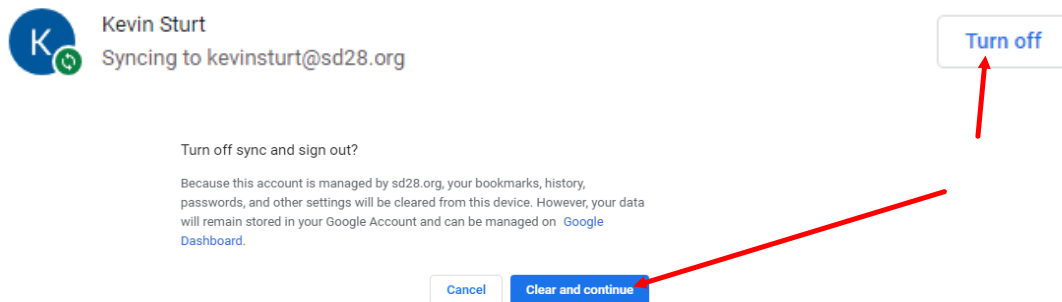
Solution 1: If there is an orange exclamation mark (!), click on it and re-enable Read&Write


Solution 2: Unfortunately, some websites do not work with Google Read&Write

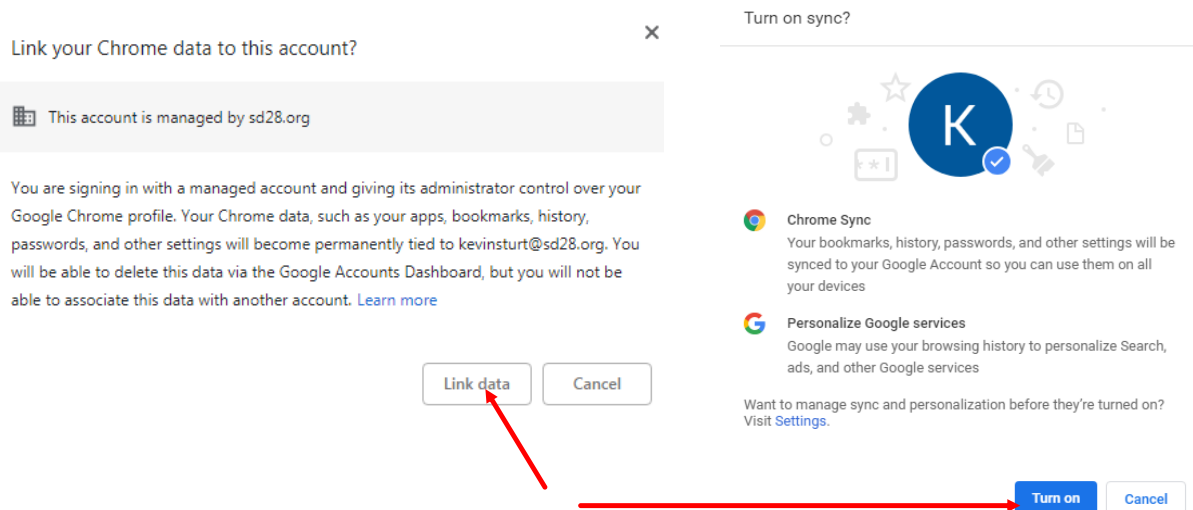


Tip#3: Google Chrome Account is "paused" or "error"...sign out & sign in again.

1. Click on the 3 dots (top right)  and go to settings.
2. Sign out or Turn off syncing



3. Sign in again by clicking on person icon () and logging in/ turning on sync with@sd28.org account. Link data!





Read&Write tools



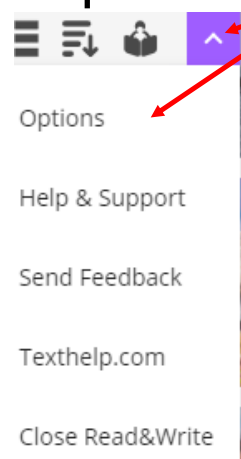
Reading tools: there are 3 ways to read

1. Select (but don't highlight) text and use play/pause/stop 

2. Hover speech  put your cursor () where you want it to read and wait a few seconds.

3. Screenshot reader  drag a box of what you want read.

****Adjust the speed in the options/ settings**




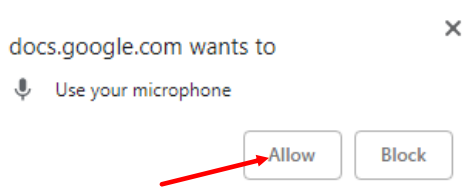
Hardware add-ons (USB ports) - mice/ headset



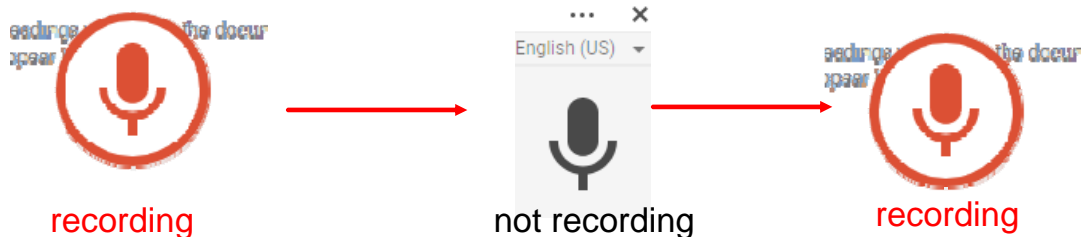
*gentle care is needed...look at how they line up! Many are already damaged!

Talk & Type Troubleshooting (Google Docs)

- * Most chromebooks have a built-in mic
- * On using the talk & type, you need to first Allow its use otherwise you can enable it by clicking on the icon () in the URL address line
- * Refresh your screen to make it work!



Red means record. If you're not ready to speak, click it off and think about what you want to say before clicking on the "talk" icon.



*Talk clearly into the mic (for chromebook, it's built into the screen beside the webcam)
